## WHY DO I NEED TO PROVE MY ABORIGINAL AND/OR TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER HERITAGE?

Your Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander heritage is something that is personal to you. You do not need a letter of confirmation to identify as an Indigenous person. However, you may be asked to provide proof or confirmation of your heritage when applying for Indigenous-specific services or programs, such as Indigenous health and wellbeing services including Smile Koomba.

These services and programs are intended to help address the inequalities Indigenous people face as a result of past government policies, inadequate health care and lack of educational and employment opportunities.

Requiring confirmation of heritage is about honouring this intention and ensuring that Indigenous-specific services and programs are actually benefitting Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people and communities.
